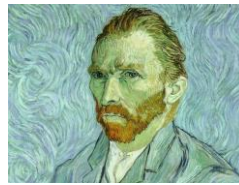

## Anne Frank Museum



Anne and her family lived in hiding from the Nazis for more than two years in a house in Amsterdam. She was eventually deported to the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp in 1945, where she later died at the young age of 15.
